

Master of Social Work (MSW)

Regular Standing (Full & Part-Time) Sample Schedule

The regular standing program is designed for students who have an undergraduate degree in a field of study other than social work. Full-time students complete the program in two years. Part-time students complete the program in three to four years.

A full-time, regular standing student's academic plan (63 credit hours) may look like this:
