### **Changes in description of Anthropology major**

First Paragraph of description of major (old):

Students majoring in Anthropology must complete a minimum of 33 hours of credit in the department. These hours must include 112, 362, and 324; and one course from each of the following: SO 100 or SO 101; 114 or 303; 317 or 319 or 320. Fifteen additional hours must be selected from these and other courses in the discipline of Anthropology. At least 18 of the required total of 33 hours must be upper division courses. Students are encouraged to take IS 170 (Library Research Strategies). Students must receive a grade of C or better in each course applied to the major.

First Paragraph of description of major (new):

Students majoring in Anthropology must complete a minimum of 33 hours of credit in the department. These hours must include AN112, AN 116, AN 324, and AN 362; and one course from each of the following: SO 100 or SO 101; AN 114 or AN 303; AN 317 or AN 319 or AN 320. In addition, students majoring in Anthropology must complete 12 credit hours by completing one AN elective, two AN upper division electives, and one AN or SO upper division elective. Students must receive a grade of C or better in each course applied to the major.
