Removed AR 260 Sculpture I (3), and AR 402 Art Forum (1), from required courses, and reduced AR 403 Workshop in Art media from 6 to 3 hrs. Added AR 404 BFA Professional Practice (2) and 3 hrs art electives to degree program. Changed General Education requirements to be consistent with all other BFA programs, a total of 38 hours of general education and University requirements. Program still requires 21 hours Professional Education courses. Total hours for BFA with Teaching Licensure is ~~147~~ 141. Under the previous degree plan, the total hours for completion was 147.
