SUBJECT: **Bachelor of Science in Mathematics**

Description: **Re-doing program changes made to all three tracks in two earlier sessions, same as for the BA degree just submitted.**

Rationale: **Changes are the same as for the BA degree just submitted. MA 343 Applied Statistics is being replaced by a choice of MA 340 or 341 for actuarial science students, a choice of MA 340, 341 or 346 for pure math, and by MA 140 for secondary education students. MA 153 Calculus III is now numbered MA 253. MA 250 Theory of Interest is now numbered MA 384. MA 204 and MA 230 are new courses, now required in math for secondary education; MA 204 replaces the PH 110 or PH 220 Logic requirement.**
