



SECTION ONE: The Washburn Student Government Association welcomes home Dr. JuliAnn Mazachek.


SECTION TWO: The Washburn Student Government Association would like to congratulate Dr. Mazachek on becoming the 15th President of Washburn University.

SECTION THREE: The Washburn Student Government Association would like to recognize and commend Dr. Mazachek, on the fact that, she is the first female president of Washburn University.


