TITLE: Recognizing February 2022 as Black History Month  
ORIGINATOR: Senator Jeter & Diversity and Inclusion Director Dorantes  
SPONSOR: Trautman/Hanes Administration  
STATUS: Diversity and Inclusion Committee – Pending Status

WHEREAS: Since 1976, every U.S. President has officially designated the month of February as Black History Month, and

WHEREAS: The history of Black History Month dates to 1915, half a century after the Thirteenth Amendment abolished slavery in the United States, and

WHEREAS: In 1926, the Association for the Study of African American Life and History (ASALH) sponsored a national Negro History week, and

WHEREAS: It would not be until the Civil Rights Movement during the 1960's that the "National Negro History Week" was recognized as "Black History Month", and

WHEREAS: Since then, Black History Month has been celebrated across the country and world. People can find businesses, schools, social media platforms, and others, celebrating Black History Month in some form, and

WHEREAS: Washburn University and the Washburn Student Government Association has and will continue to spread awareness about Black History Month as well as support it, and

WHEREAS: Black students and their excellence shall continue to be recognized and cherished, and

WHEREAS: The Washburn Student Government Association values Black representation and Black efforts throughout history, the now, and the future.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

SECTION ONE: The Washburn Student Government Association recognizes February 2022 as Black History Month.

SECTION TWO: The Washburn Student Government Association recognizes this year's theme being "Black Health and Wellness".

SECTION THREE: The Washburn Student Government Association will help promote and share information regarding Black culture and events that Washburn's Black Student Union is hosting.
